PROSHRED's mobile shredding trucks will be onsite to securely shred your confidential documents for **FREE**.

(Maximum of 10 file storage boxes size 1'x2')

- Trucks are capable of shredding paper with no need to remove paperclips or staples.
- Paper **MUST BE** removed from 3 ring binders.
- All 3 ring binders, containers, and cardboard boxes will be returned to you.



Secure e-Cycle will be onsite collecting electronics for responsible recycling.

There will be a small fee (cash or check) for PC Monitors \$15, TV's \$25 and **EVERYTHING ELSE WITH A CORD IS FREE**.
