- Public meeting and survey monkey to put into concepts for the playground
- Have a master plan as a separate cost/proposal
- Timeline- master plan in concert with the playground- would be later this fall
- Going to the public once
- Have the master plan as a separate item
 - Put option into the master plan to explore some grants

Discussion/updates/new items:

- Nall Park Master Plan- next steps and recommendation from Parks
 - Revise proposal to focus on the master plan
 - Hybrid option-integrated with the grade
 - Motion carried unanimously for Lamp Ryneerson for the Master plan, leave open option for playground design with Confluence-
 - 24th of July Council will vote on this
- Goat update
 - Wintercreeper, other invasives- need to discuss what we will do after the goats come. Judy is meeting Anthony tomorrow at 2:00 at Nall
 - Need to make sure it is cost effective and have a plan for afterwards
- Undesirable native plants (poison ivy, etc.) near pathways in Cooper Creek Park
 - Worked to remove invasive, and replant native grasses and perennials and replace invasive trees with native trees
 - Monitor and manage so it doesn't encroach on areas where people would be sitting
 - Habitat Architects will do upkeep, and Public Works
 - Habitat Architects to help us address- Park Maintenance
 - Anthony will contact them
- Memorial Donation request for rose bush

- Only have a process for trees. Native planting in/near Wildflower meadow?
 - Laura will get with her on doing so

Cooper Creek:

- updates- **Judy/Laura**
 - Interpretive sign went in to the Park, native gardens looking great
 - Sidewalk and planting around new interpretive sign should be going in soon
- Play equipment update/balance beam?
 - Daniel should be working on finalizing
- Any updates on erosion

- Habitat Architects are planting native trees, starting review
- Will review the tree growth every year

Nall Park:

- Goats to clear Nall- Anthony looking into
 - Only hold up is to figure out after goats or done, or if they can come twice a year
 - 25-30 goats will be there for a week and will have a route to clear
 - Generate excitement about our future plans in Nall Park
 - #NALLPARKGOAT
 - Check on safety issues with coyotes
- Update on timeline and budget
- Construction is moved out to 2026, money for new PW this year and 2025 Nall Park is community center phase 2, due to timeline constraints
 - 2023 for revising master plan
 - *Reminder on next steps on Nall Park Master plan update*
- Next steps:
 - Select/Finalize vendor to update the master plan
 - Discuss ideas with Design/Construction vendor
 - Master plan (work with) and the City Engineer
 - Both Parks and Council approval
 - Community forum/feedback
 - Dots exercise or other means of feedback
 - Group planning and review of detailed plans/any edits
 - Final plan/any changes requires Parks and Council approval
 - Execution
 - Sewer work has impacted the trail- any updates (no longer getting response from Urban Trails)-
 - *Ask PW if it's a safety issue as far as the sewer work portion*
 - *KS Heavy is going to fix it with sod, grass, adding signage to stay on the trail*
 - *Have an idea to fix it with grading and planting*
 - *and then for future maintenance if there's another non-profit trail group that will work with us., Anthony did get ahold of someone*
 - update? Anthony got ahold of someone with the contract
 - need ideas for future trail maintenance still
 - A Federal Land and Water Conservation grant for contribution of costs to the Nall Park- possibly for inclusive play.
 - Builder is investigating the grant to start along with Laura
 - Welcome other ideas

R Park:

- Discuss R Park Bathroom Safety
 - Any locks have to be opened from the inside without opening the lock- hospitals have that kind of locks
 - Everyone voted to add these locks
 - Prices look good- not a huge expensive
 - Port a potties are very cheap for good events
- Future discussion on R Park planting/watering
 - \$2200 reserved for this already in the R Park "bucket" from Citizens Fundraising for R Park

- irrigation
- Colors for R Park post- painting Teal
 - Can paint match and do this shortly
 - Have two recent hires in PW, so fully staffed shortly
- R Park- Clean-up/issues to address
 - Bollards – Replacement, sturdier bollards people driving around them- plastic bollards might be better
 - Also possibly consider landscaping along there
 - Junipers?
 - Metal are 200, plastic are 25
 - They were installed yesterday!
- Basketball court- *Better basketball goals might be better and other options for a light re-surface*
 - Estimate?
 - Consider for objective next year, council project, 2-3 council members?
- R Park- "Mighty Bike" Sculpture- *Matt/Laura*
 - Progress meeting, engineers have drawn everything, need a contract
 - New finance director Micah will help alleviate some burden with this
 - Matt out at the Park with the head of the project for PW, asked by the City of their contract will take on the Might Bike project
 - Donating their services
- R Park- Wildflower Meadow Subcommittee- Jaime
 - Extra dirt with Roe project
 - Next steps on Seed mix and digging holes to plant- likely October
 - Maybe Bishop Meige can help again?
 - There is a club that does something like that at Bishop Miede
- R Park- Ash disposal- how we handle safely
 - Johnson County Waste Services- takes ash disposal?
 - Bucket?- how do citizens dispose of
 - Pw picks it up once a week-
 - put in the Parking lot
- Omission on the plaque
 - Mayor Poppa noticed every dept head mentioned except Chief Morris, consider a change
 - Russell has the artwork on it, see if we can add Chief John Morris and the RP Police
 - Laura and Russell working on.
- Tree near playground has low hanging branches- kids hanging off of them and broken branches on the ground.
- One of the infant sears is broken on the swings
