- Watering- Anthony is working on a bid for it
 - Anthony still working on for irrigation, on the list for a Budget Objective
 - Donnie working with Anthony on it- PW focused
 - Due to weather, no movement recently

Nall Park:

- Update on timeline and budget- Master Plan
 - Should be an update to Council this month
- Timeline reminder- Construction is moved out to 2026, money for new PW this year and 2025 Nall Park is community center phase 2, due to timeline constraints
 - Next steps:
 - Select/Finalize vendor to update the master plan- complete
 - Discuss ideas with Design/Construction vendor- in progress
 - Master plan (work with) and the City Engineer
 - Both Parks and Council approval
 - Community forum/feedback
 - Dots exercise or other means of feedback
 - Group planning and review of detailed plans/any edits
 - Final plan/any changes requires Parks and Council approval
 - Execution
- Sewer work has impacted the trail- any updates (no longer getting response from Urban Trails)
 - Ask PW if it's a safety issue as far as the sewer work portion
 - KS Heavy is going to fix it with sod, grass, adding signage to stay on the trail
 - Not sure when it will happen with the weather
 - City Council has a contact for this
 - need ideas for future trail maintenance still

R Park:

- Future discussion on R Park planting/watering

- \$2200 reserved for this already in the R Park “bucket” from Citizens Fundraising for R Park
 - irrigation
- Colors for R Park post- painting Teal
 - Can paint match and do this shortly
 - Have painted some of the equipment so far, rest when weather permits
- R Park- "Mighty Bike" Sculpture- Matt
 - Costs higher than expected for fabrication, met with a fabricator that has some potential, wants a full construction drawing set- we had planned to do shop drawings
 - Another group interested in doing a bid
 - Should have back Thursday or Friday this week
- R Park- Wildflower Meadow Subcommittee- Jaime
 - Check out planted area!
- R Park-Large trash cans and recycling bins
- Omission on the plaque- update?
 - Donnie is working on who did the original- new plaque for \$1200- Kate will work with Council on it
- Kustom Signals- speed trackers in traffic garden

Discussion-

Parking Lot

- R Park
- Maple tree on NE corner- appears to be sickly- see if needs to be trimmed/removed- **PW**
 - To address in spring, place in parking lot
- Basketball court-*Better basketball goals might be better and other options for a light re-surface*
 - Estimate?
 - Consider for objective next year, council project, 2-3 council members?
- Birch tree on NW corner- erosion
 - **Daniel**- eroding on south Side of the tree- something may need to be engineered-Laura talked to Daniel, they are going to wait and see what happens with drainage
- Sweaney – play structure
- Tree/Art markers
- Making adjustments to the objective
- Project will be around 13-16 K
- 2024 budget item
- **Anthony/Daniel** will work to incorporate Arbor Master’s tree inventory for a tree replacement schedule for entire Park system. Budget to be established.
