- Presentation by Mike Miller, Citizens Climate Lobby

Mike presented Citizen's Climate lobby recommendations for updated building codes based on the 2024 International Energy Conservation Code, which they are trying to get approved in by municipalities across Johnson County.

Existing codes used by the majority of the county are from 2015, and include so many admendments that the code is similar to the efficiency of 2006 codes.

Newly proposed code is expected to increase new-build building energy efficiency by 20% through better air sealing in duct work and walls, thicker exterior walls allowing for more insullation, etc.

Proposed code is based on a flexible compliance model, rather than strict guidelines for every aspect of a building. They expect this will make it easier for builders to comply with the code.

Mike mentioned that CCL *strongly* recommends that this code be adopted without amendments in order to preserve its efficacy.
